All the produce is purchased locally when in season, all dry goods are from local companies whenever possible, plastic, metal and paper materials used in menu planning are recycled, non-disposable dishes, glassware and cutlery are used whenever possible, cleaning supplies are environmentally friendly, anything that needs to be printed is printed on recycled paper, and also features in-house composting. As catering and the food plays a huge role in our event, using a sustainable catering company such as the AMS shows our commitment to sustainability.

## **How to Submit the Funding Application**

Completed forms can be emailed to <a href="mailto:sec.ubc@gmail.com">sec.ubc@gmail.com</a> (preferred) or dropped off at our office, Room 2106 of in the AMS Student Nest, during office hours<sup>1</sup>. You are also welcome (but not required) to attend our weekly meetings<sup>2</sup> to present your project idea to our group, though we would appreciate an email informing us of this intent at least 48 hours ahead of time. The executive team and other active members of SEC would be happy to help you formulate your project as well as assist with its development and applications for funding.

If your funding application is approved, the Student Environment Centre will reimburse you for the specified purchases and expenses. You will then be referred to our Treasurer, whom you must provide with receipts and/or proof-of-purchases. Reimbursement usually takes about 5 business days. In the event that a student is unable to make the necessary purchase(s) to start their project, arrangements for advance funding can be made.

## A Note about Eco-Initiatives Grants

Eco-Initiatives Grants can be used to fund a wide variety of projects: any projects related to the environment or sustainability, and involving members of the UBC student body, will be considered. However, funding requests for projects undertaken as part of coursework at UBC, or individual volunteer projects, must illustrate a connection to the wider student body.
